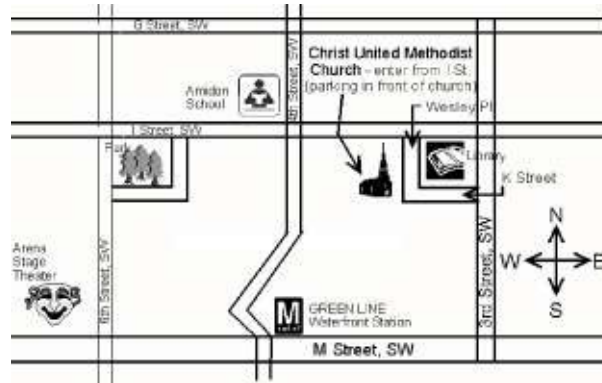

The WASHINGTON STAMP COLLECTORS CLUB (WSCC) was formed on January 1, 12006, through a merger of the Collectors Club of Washington and the Washington Philatelic Society, to foster philatelic enjoyment and educational benefits to stamp collectors in the Washington, DC area. The WSCC provides a wide variety of activities for the stamp collector, including buying, selling, and trading stamps, meeting programs of interest to new and advanced collectors, frequent auctions, U.S. and worldwide circuits at each meeting, an award winning newsletter, and many other activities.



The WSCC is engaged in a variety of activities of interest to the stamp collector. Meetings are held twice monthly, the first and third Wednesdays of the month, all year round. The meeting location is in the waterfront section of Southwest Washington a short distance from the

Waterfront Metrorail Station. Frequently featured are presentations by member and guest collectors. An auction is held every two month, where stamps, covers, philatelic literature and other interesting items are bought and sold. United Stamp Societies sale circuits are a feature at every meeting. An annual awards banquet and a popular Holiday Auction and Party are held. Refreshments are available at each meeting.

A First Day Cover program is also maintained by the club. Selected new issues are chosen and special cachets are created. First day cancellations are

obtained and the covers are sold to members at a small increase over costs.

Our bi-monthly newsletter, *WASHINGTON CITY DESPATCH*, lists upcoming programs, area club shows and nearby World Series of Philately exhibitions; as well as articles on District of Columbia postal history, interesting stories of philatelic interest, and news of members.

The WSCC maintains a web site, www.dcstampclub.org, to keep members and the public apprised of our activities. In addition to the normal membership forms and previous newsletters, DC postal history publications are available to download at no charge.



The WSCC has six classes of membership; Regular, Life, Non-resident Regular, Non-resident Life, Junior and Honorary. A Junior member is defined as any member younger than 18 years old. A Non-resident Regular member is a member who does not reside permanently in the Washington, DC metropolitan area and normally cannot meetings due to geographic distance. The membership year is July 1 through June 30. Regular Membership dues are \$16.00 annually; Non-resident Regular and Junior dues are \$8.00 annually. For Life membership fees, contact the Executive Secretary.

WSCC is Life Chapter 18 of the American Philatelic Society, Chapter 55 of the American Topical Association, and an associate club of the Virginia Philatelic Federation.
